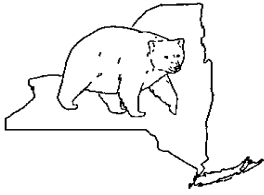

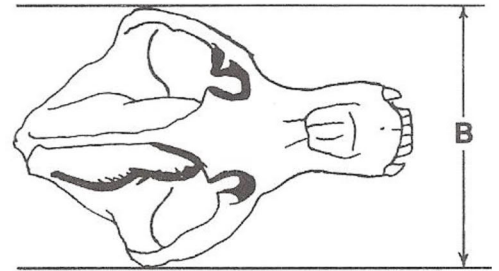
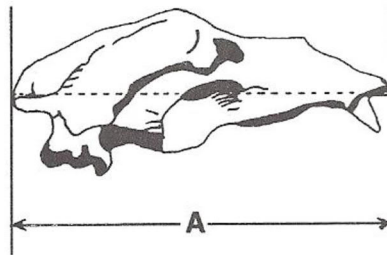

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEASURING BEAR SKULLS

All measurements must be taken between parallel perpendiculars or with calipers. Measurements must be taken to the nearest one-sixteenth of an inch and recorded in sixteenths.

Official measurements cannot be taken for at least 60 days from date of kill. All flesh, membrane and cartilage must be removed completely before measuring. (When the skull is boiled it must be air dried before measurement.)

A. The Greatest Skull Length is measured between perpendiculars, parallel to the longest axis of the skull after lower jaw has been removed.

B. Greatest Width is measured between perpendiculars, at a right angle to the longest axis.
